Waardi welcomes stringent environmental conditions

The new administration body for the Traditional Owners of Jabirr Jabirr country has welcomed the stringent conditions imposed by the EPA on its approval for the Browse LNG project at James Price Point.

Waardi Ltd Chairperson, Warren Greatorex, said today that the recommendations and stringent conditions were the result of an extensive and thorough consultation process

“We were part of the consultation process and we were given an opportunity to express our concerns relating to environmental, cultural and heritage matters and impacts,” Mr Greatorex said. “It has been an extensive, long and arduous process. People have had the opportunity to have their say and air their concerns.

“As the administration body for the Traditional Owners of Jabirr Jabirr country where the project is planned, we feel our cultural and heritage interests have been heard. We are very pleased and reassured by the stringent conditions designed to restrict and limit environmental impacts at James Price Point.”

Mr Greatorex said Waardi was keen to work with Woodside to ensure the recommendations contained in the EPA report are adhered to.

“We want to make sure measures and mechanisms are included within their environmental management plans that are sound and enforce the stringent conditions.”
